## Planning and Advanced Reservation of Capacity Agreement (PARCA)

## **NOTICE: PARCA APPLICATION - ALLOCATION OF NTS EXIT CAPACITY**

## 26<sup>th</sup> September, 2017

Dear Industry Colleague,

In accordance with Uniform Network Code, Section B, National Grid hereby publishes this notice to all interested parties.

On the 24<sup>th</sup> March, 2017, National Grid issued a notice<sup>1</sup>, with respect to a competent Planning & Advanced Reservation of Capacity Agreement ("PARCA") application. The PARCA application was for National Transmission System ("NTS") exit capacity between 3,163,000kWh/d and 5,167,000kWh/d in the North East, Yorkshire and Lincolnshire (Region 3 as defined in Gas Ten Year Statement<sup>2</sup>). The indicative capacity Reservation Date specified at the time was 17<sup>th</sup> September, 2017.

On 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2017, National Grid issued an informal notice<sup>3</sup>, which outlined our proposals to meet the capacity requirement of 5,167,000kWh/d with an indicative capacity Registration Date of 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2017.

On 30<sup>th</sup> August, 2017, National Grid issued a notice to confirm the PARCA Application had progressed to PARCA Phase 2, and 5,167,000kWh/d of NTS exit capacity has been reserved. On the same day National Grid issued a formal notice to The Authority<sup>4</sup>. The Registration Date was 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2017.

System exit capacity was reserved at the following donor exit points from the date specified in the table below for the purposes of exit capacity substitution.

On 20<sup>th</sup> September, 2017, The Authority informed National Grid of its decision not to veto the substitution proposal.

Today, 26<sup>th</sup> September, 2017, National Grid is issuing this notice to confirm that from 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2017;

- 1. The volume of Enduring Annual NTS Exit (Flat) Capacity allocated is 5,167,000kWh/d.
- 2. The incremental volume (being the volume above Baseline NTS Exit (Flat) Capacity) of Enduring Annual NTS (Flat) Capacity allocated is 5,167,000kWh/d.
