

Planning and Advanced Reservation of Capacity (PARCA)

NOTICE: WITHDRAWAL OF A PARCA APPLICATION

12 May 2020

Dear Industry Colleague,

In accordance with the Uniform Network Code, Section B, National Grid hereby publishes this notice to all interested industry parties.

On 21st January, we published a notice to inform of the opening of a PARCA Exit Window on **Wednesday, 22nd January 2020**. The application was as follows;

Application 1

- The geographical area of the project was North East Yorkshire and Lincolnshire (Region 3 as defined in Gas Ten Year Statement¹). This region was South of Bishop Auckland, north of Peterborough and Wisbech and east of Nether Kellet, and comprised NTS/DN exit zones NE1, 2, EM1, 2.
- The quantity of the NTS exit capacity applied for was up to 3,716,149 kWh/d.
- The indicative capacity reservation date was 21st May 2020.
- The indicative capacity registration date was 1st April 2026.

We are issuing this notice to inform that the PARCA application has been withdrawn.
