Application 1

- The geographical area of the project is North East Yorkshire and Lincolnshire (Region 3 as defined in Gas Ten Year Statement¹). This region is South of Bishop Auckland, north of Peterborough and Wisbech, and east of Nether Kellet, and comprises NTS/DN exit zones NE1, 2, EM1, 2.
- The quantity of the NTS exit capacity applied for is 39,776,149 kWh/d.
- The indicative capacity reservation date is 31 May 2023.
- The indicative capacity Registration Date is 1 December 2027.

The PARCA Exit Window will be opened for a maximum of 40 consecutive business days from 1 February 2023, closing on 30 March 2023. If no further PARCA Applications are received within 20 consecutive business days, the window will be closed on 2 March 2023.
